Unit Studies

Next week we will be starting our simple machines science unit! We talk about screws, inclined planes, pulleys, wheels and axles, wedges, and levers. We do group investigations, scavenger hunts, and watch short, education videos about these topics and write notes. Instead of a traditional assessment at the end of the unit, students will complete a final project at home (either a compound machine-think Rube Goldberg or a poster of simple machines used in a park). I will show a few student examples from previous years. Instructions will be sent home at least 2 weeks before the project due date. Your children have seen what their classmates in 5A have brought in, so they might already have some ideas of what they would like theirs to be like. Our other science topics for the school year include these topics: changes in matter, human bodies/nutrition, and weather.
